

Legislative Update (revised 9/23/22)

AB 2242 (SANTIAGO-skid row, LA) Early Intervention & Prevention - involuntary treatment under conservatorship which is a change to the intent, requires additional are coordination during conservatorship/temp holds and discharge. CBHDA opposed the bill. Saw almost unanimous support in the legislature. Still awaiting governor's response.

SB 970 (EGGMAN) MHSA OAR- requires Health & human Services Agency to establish the MHSA Outcomes & Accountability Review (OAR). Creates a dedicated workgroup tasked with establishing three specified components to assist and review CMHP's. While the bill did die in Appropriations due to fiscal costs, it received overwhelming support from the policy committees it was reviewed by. It may come back in the future- might mean additional layers of reporting in different formats.

SB 1302 (PORTANTINO) CA Dept of Education Grant- vetoed 9/28/22. Would take \$250M MHSA funds at state level and provide that to CA Dept of Education for grant program (up to \$250K to LEA's and High schools with aim of enhancing or establishing mental health services at campus health centers.) last minute gut (gutted means bill number remained and everything else removed), and amendment by Sen. Portantino and saw significant legislative support. Bill awaiting governor's response.

CARE court update: CARE court was passed in California. Provides minimal funding which will be allocated to 7 counties for pilot implementation. Alameda County will be required to implement it by 2023 with no funding. Not a lot of guidance. It will be sanctioned if it's not up and running.


